This Focus of the Month will discuss ways you can **be Pro-Active** when re-ordering **Class 3, 4 and 5's**

Take a moment to review your narcotic labels (medications in narcotic bubble packs)

On the label next to the drug description, it will have a:

- \*C\* = means the medication is a **Class 3, 4 or 5** (see label above – arrow A)
- \*C2\* = means the medication is a Class 2

When re-ordering your \*C\* = **Class 3,4 or 5** you want to look at the back of the bubble pack.

On the label you should see a Ref = *refills left* (see label above – arrow B)

If you see that the label reads... **ref - 1**. This means the medication is on its last refill.

When re-ordering the medication and the label reads **ref - 1**:

- Pull the re-order sticker
- Place the sticker on the re-order form
- Underneath the sticker write - **send new narc script**. (Or call)
- This will allow Skilled Care to send you a *new narc script* for the Dr to sign before the medication runs out.
- When the Dr signs the script, fax back to Skilled Care
